Participants: ZLATAR Duty Officer – PALMA Duty officer

P – Hello Zlatar. Give me the duty officer.

Z – Yes.

P – Palma duty officer speaking. 500 litres of D2 /diesel fuel/ for Lt. Col. POPOVIĆ.

Z – For Lt. Col. POPOVIĆ.

P – Yes.

Line disconnects. The switchboard operator asks: Who's there?

P – Palma duty officer.

C – Who do you want?

P – I want to talk to the Zlatar duty officer.

X – Hello! How did you get connected here?

P – Hello, is that BAŠEVIĆ?

X – What?

P – Is that BAŠEVIĆ?

X – Just a moment.

P – Hello, is that BAŠEVIĆ?

B – Yes, it's me.

P – The guys at Zlatar didn't understand well. I asked for the operations duty officer,
you know.

B – Yes.

P – Lt. Col. POPOVIĆ is here at Palma, you know.

B – What?

P – POPOVIĆ is at Palma.

B – Yes.

P – 500 litres of D2 are urgently being asked for him or else the work he's doing will stop.

B – Well, fuck him, don't you have 500 litres of oil? They are asking for 2 tons loaded.

P – Let me tell you, I don't know. He just called me from the field and told me to pass you the message over there.

B – Two tons are coming to your place and /?two men/ can't find oil. Should I deliver it to them by helicopter?

P – Well, you should talk to Rošević than?

(line disconnected)

C – Did you get BAŠEVIĆ?

P – Yes I did and who is that? Is that duty officer?

C – The switchboard.

P – Give me the operations duty officer.

Is Major GOLIC there perhaps?

C – Yes.

P – Yes, let me talk to him.

C – GOLIC, Pop just called me and told me to contact you. 500 litres of D2 have to be sent to him immediately, otherwise his work will stop.

Yeah, man.

Yeah, 500 litres, or else his work will stop.

Go on, right away.

G – Bye.

(Immediately after end of the conversation)

P – A bus loaded with oil is to go to Pilica village.

That's it.

X – 500 l.

P – No, it should go with its fuel tank from the transport battalion.

X – So, it's separate.

P – Yes, yes, it should be separate.

X - ...

P – There is but Lt. Col. KRSMANOVIC over at you place has to call here to the transport battalion.

X - ...

P – Please do. Goodbye.
